As a result, rather than reporting on recent conferences, this special Issue adds two invited contributions presented at the ISS 2017 (December, Tokyo, Japan); one from the Materials section involving recent progress in MgB₂ wires, and one from the Large Scale section on the fabrication and properties of superconducting joints of REBCO coated conductors.

In the "Science and Technology Highlights" section, we have two contributions from materials research: one covers REBCO conductor for accelerator magnets and the other conveys record critical current densities reached in highly-textured 122 iron-based superconducting tapes.
